

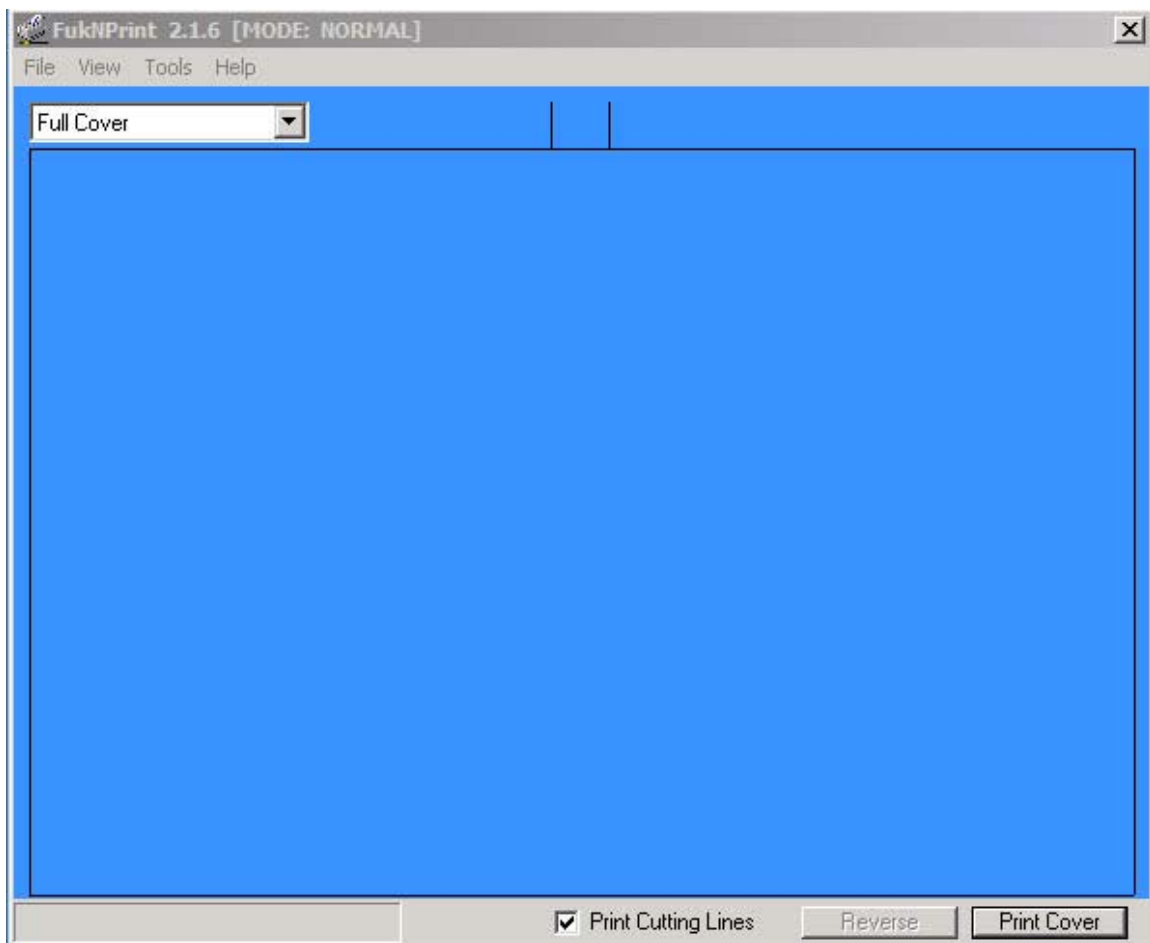
FukNPrint DVD Covers Guide (Part 1)

Here is what the updated Program looks like in Normal Mode.

Modes available:

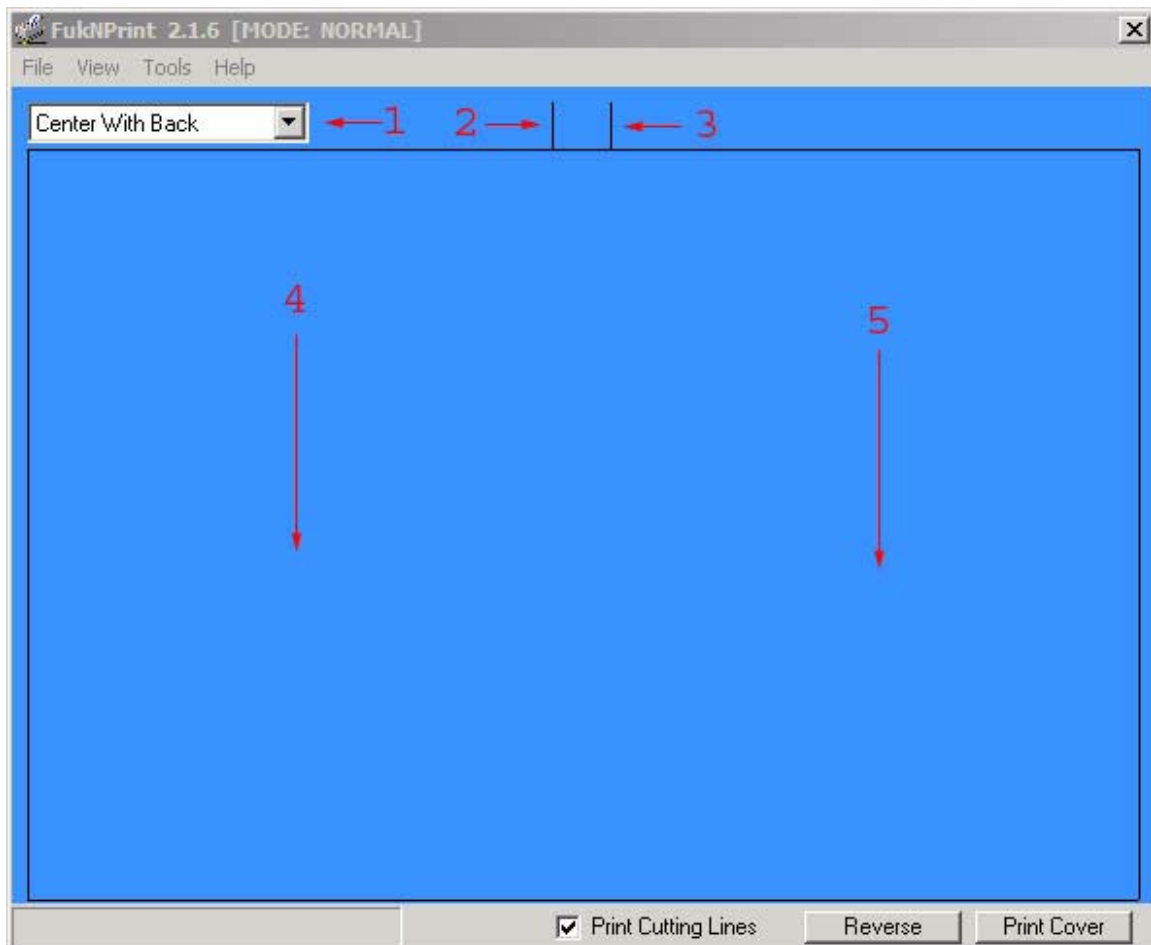
1. Normal
2. Download
3. Multi-Print

All functionality in normal mode works just as it did in the previous versions, or as shown in the first part of this guide.



Here is some of the original functionality.

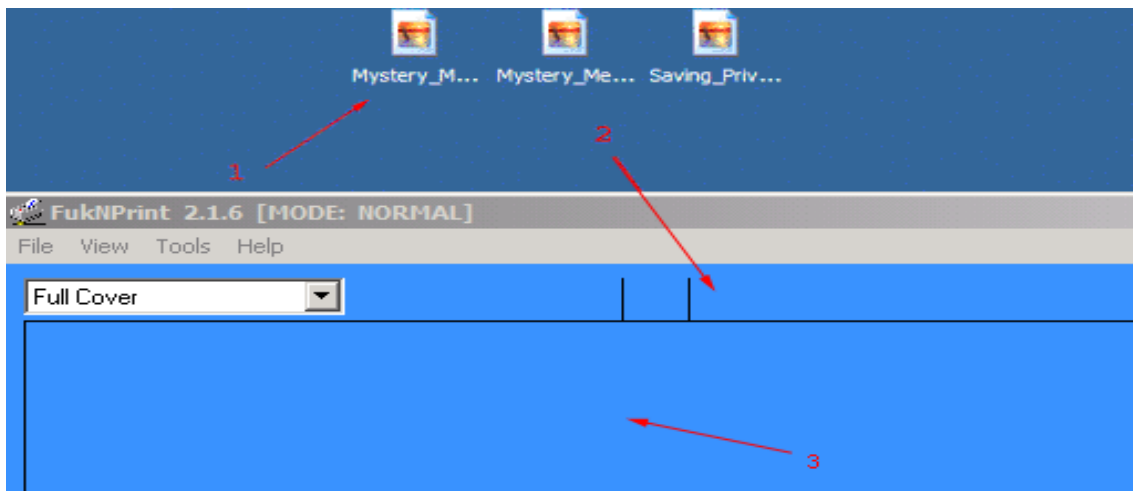
1. Select the type of cover you want to print.
 - a. DVD covers most of the time are scanned as one big image.
 - b. Are two images with center on back scan
 - c. Are two images with center on front scan
2. Roughly where Back Side lines up.
3. Roughly where Front side lines up (center between 2 &3)
4. Where back side should be
5. Where the front side should be



You simply can drag and drop files, as well as go to File>Open to load them.

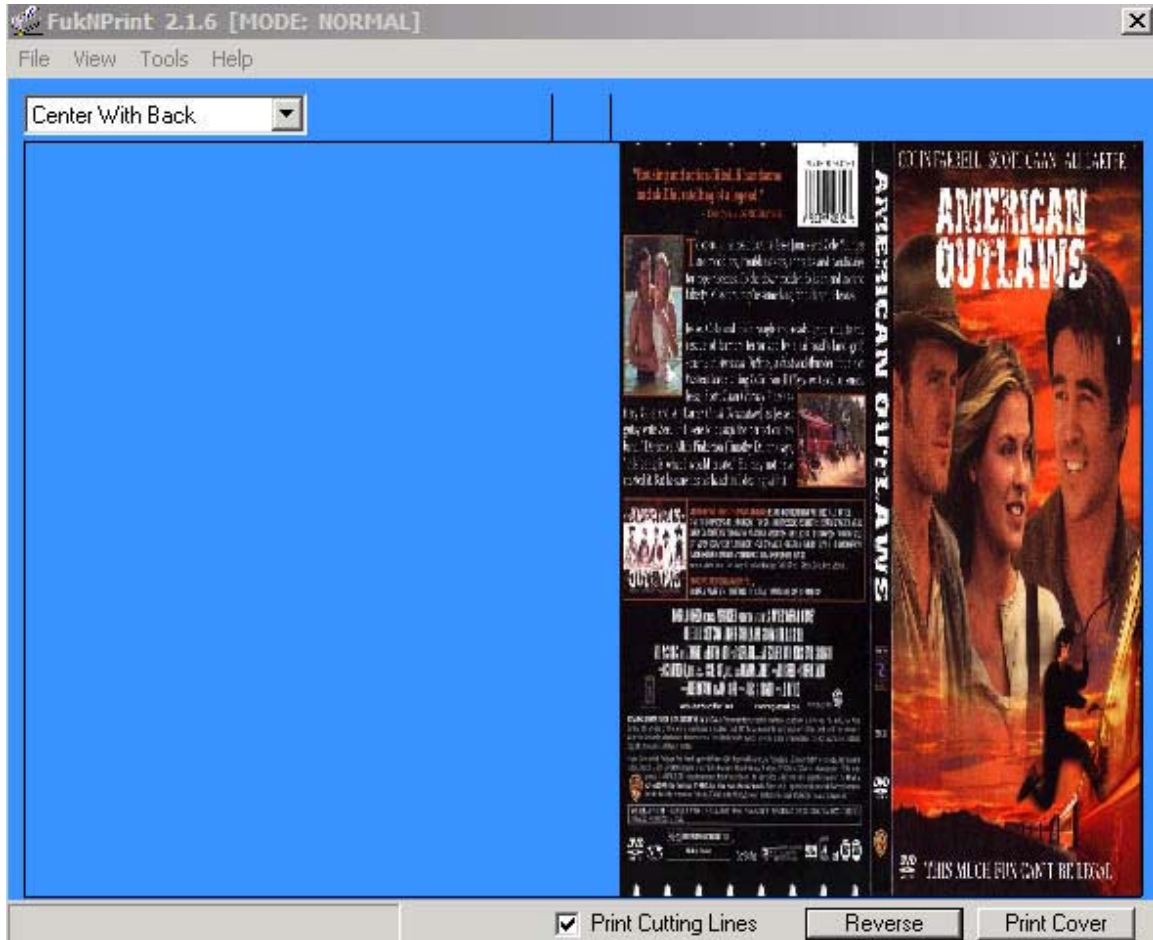
1. Pick a file and drag it anywhere on the form, when NO pictures are loaded.
2. Any part of form outside of main rectangle you can always drop images onto.
3. Can only drop an image inside this area when no other picture is loaded.

Note the mystery men cover that is beside the one is a two part cover, currently should you drag one side in to the full cover mode, it will be stretched when you choose the drop down to select the appropriate cover type, it will clear the image box (should you go to/from Full Cover. It is a single image box, whereas the split covers require two boxes.

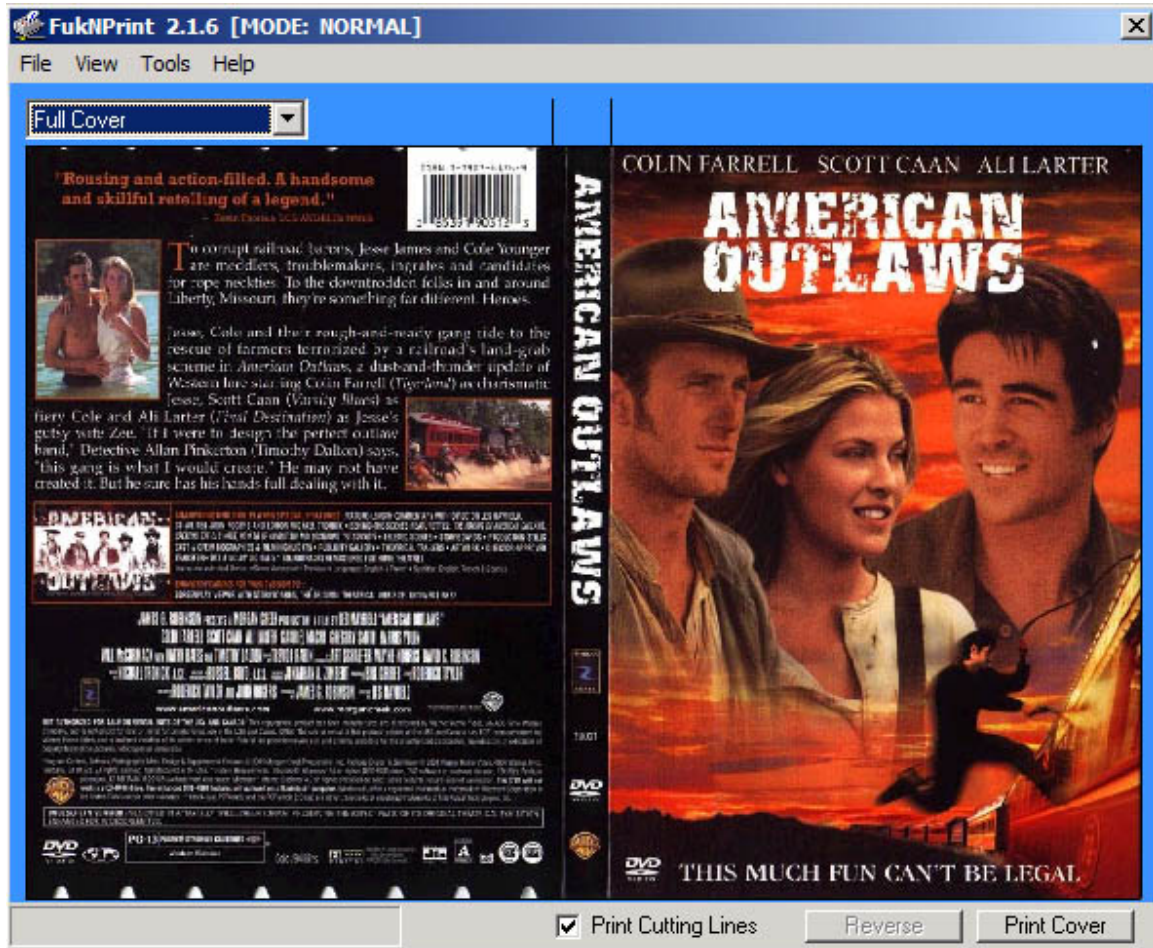


Should you load a cover in the wrong mode, you can tell. The ratio on the screen should be exactly what the cover will look like on paper.

1. American Outlaws is a full cover; it should stretch the entire width. See the next shot.



Here is what a correctly loaded cover will look like.

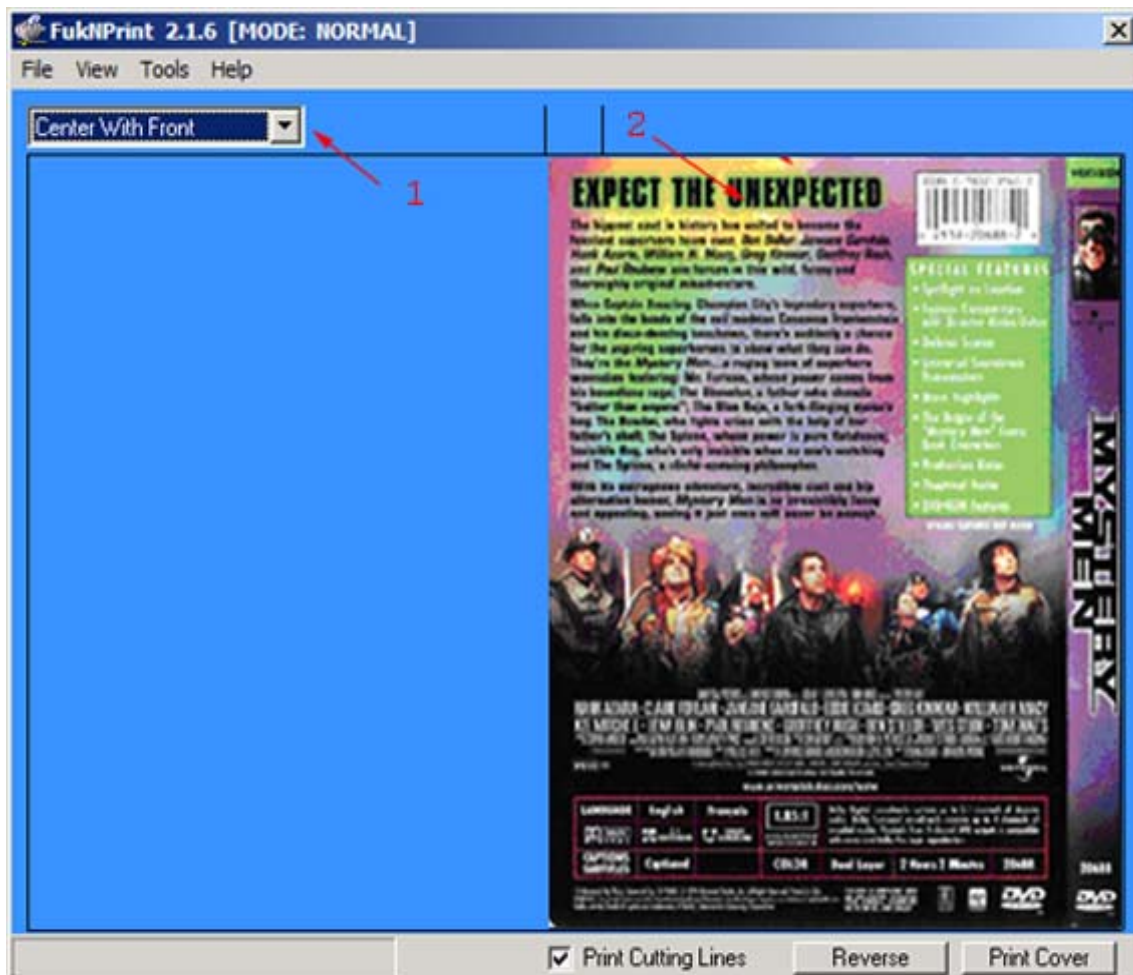


Where other cover programs I have seen fail.

Cover Magic does not support loading multiple images. We join the two images in Photoshop then print them.

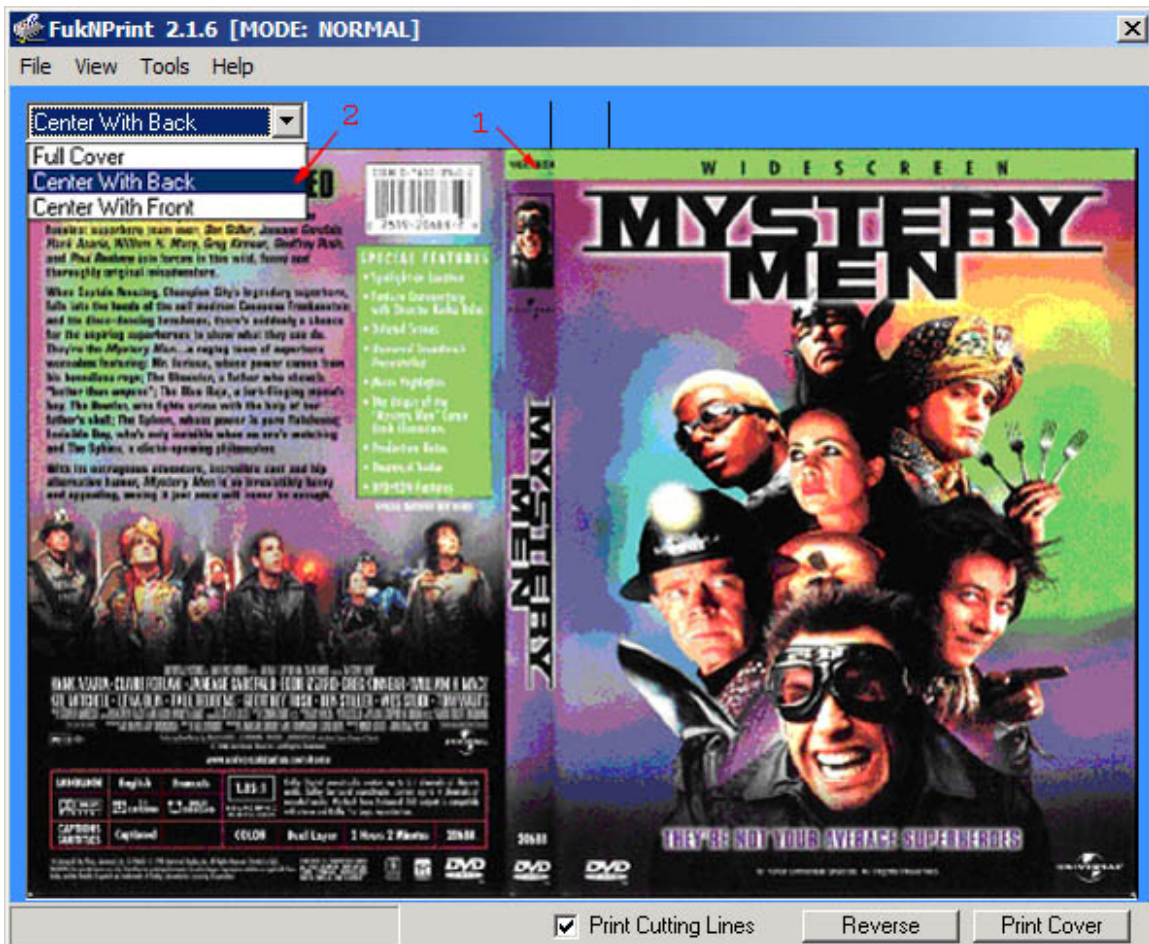
FukNPrint eliminates the need to do so.

1. Select the Appropriate Cover type (Center is actually with back see cover image in picture)
2. Drag image 1 onto the form (image is back, image 1 of 2 is always loaded to front picture).



Now that you have the two Positions corrected. Do you still see that picture 2; the back has the center attached to it. You selected “Center With Front” for the type of cover. The center is part of back, it is stretched wrong. Now Drop down the box to Center with back.

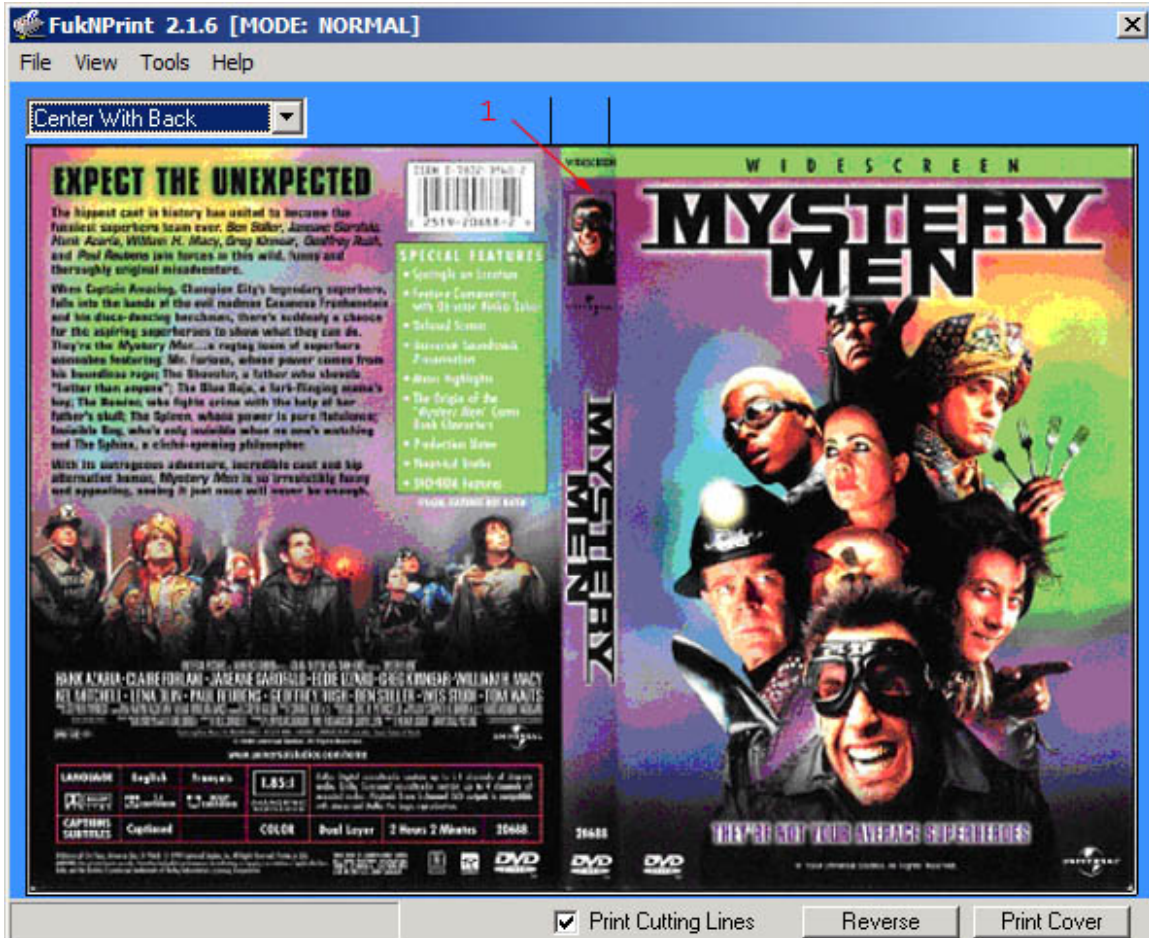
1. Back side of cover with center part of image, (currently in wrong aspect ratio)
2. Drop down to set right aspect ratio.



Once the type is set to “Center With Back” for this particular movie, the center should fall inside my markers to roughly tell where the center should be.

1. Center should fall between vertical lines.

Now you are ready to click the print button.



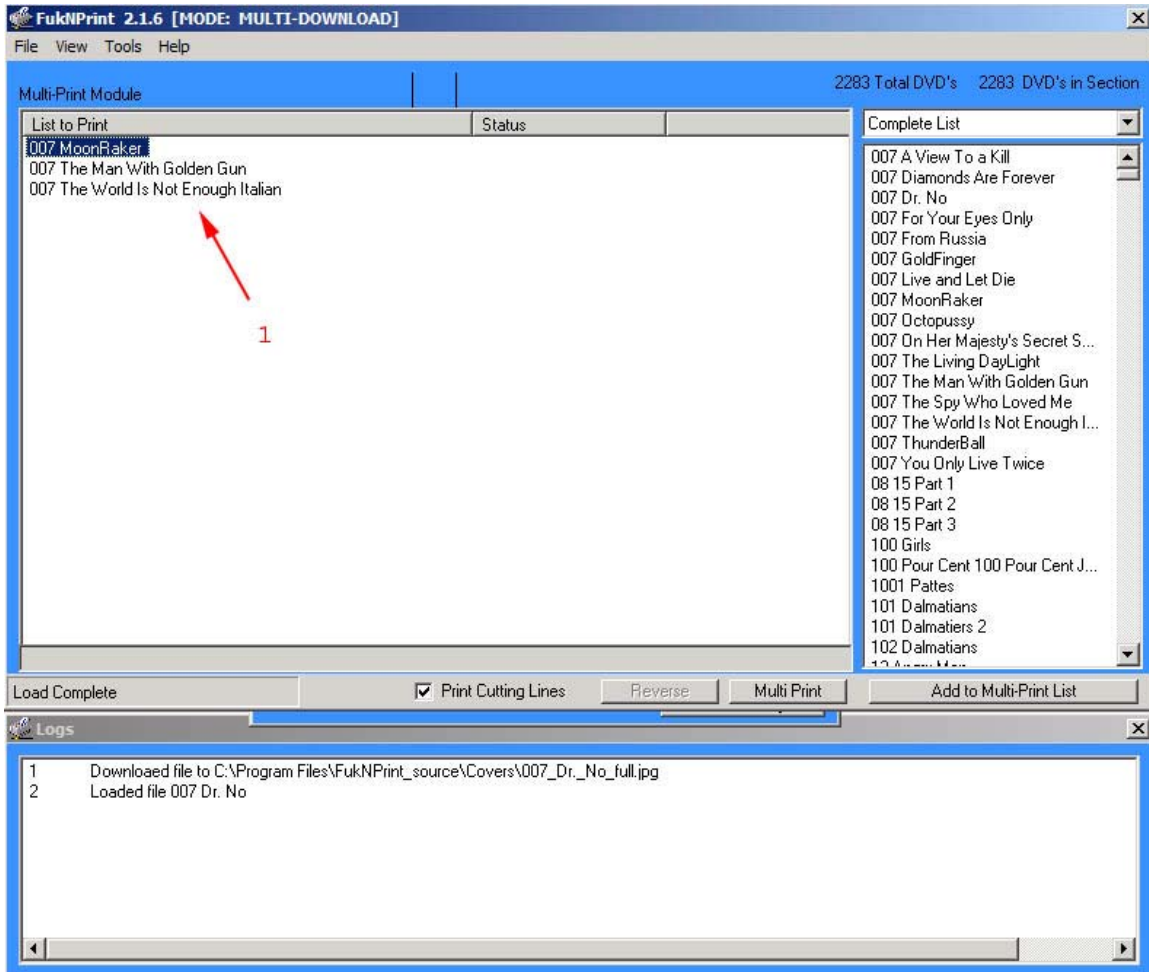
Download Module

1. Select Cover to Download (Double Click or Download Button will download Cover)
2. Download the Selected Cover
3. Area Image is loaded.



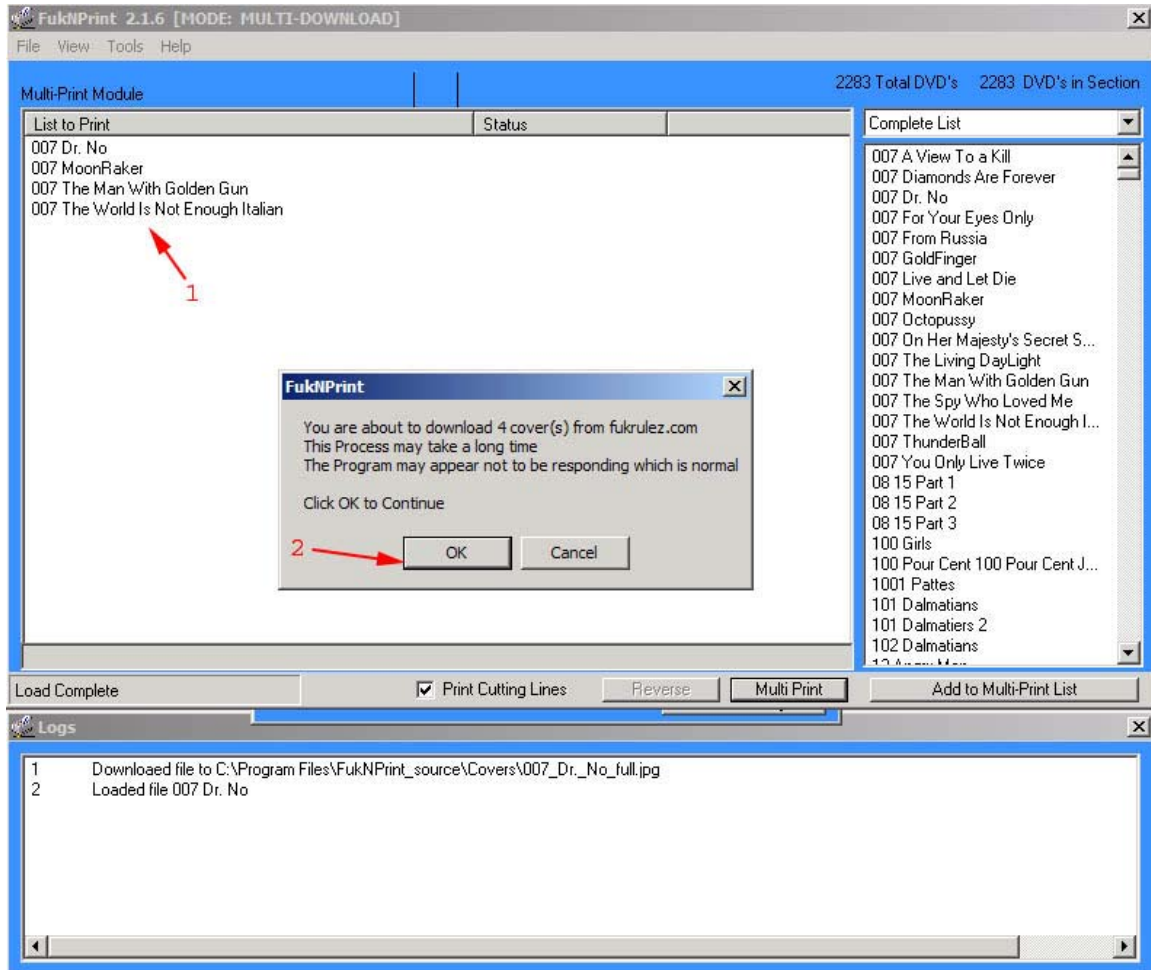
Download Module w/ Multi-print Module loaded too.

1. Area that list is stored. Add Covers to print from the download module by selecting them, and then pressing the button “Add to Multi-Print List.”



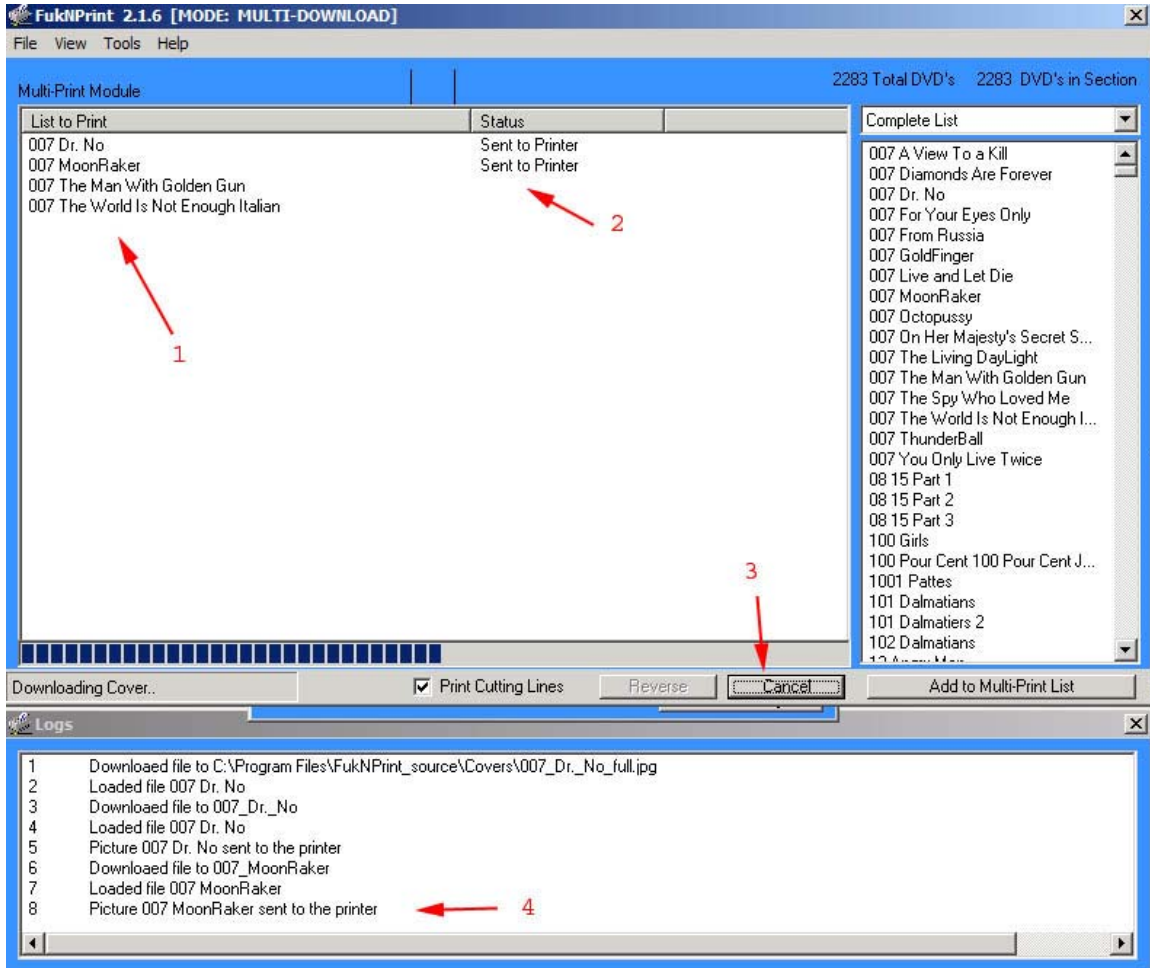
Printing in Multi-Print mode..

1. Print List
2. Click okay to Download and Print x number covers from Fukrulez.com



Status of FukNPrint after multi-print starts print process.

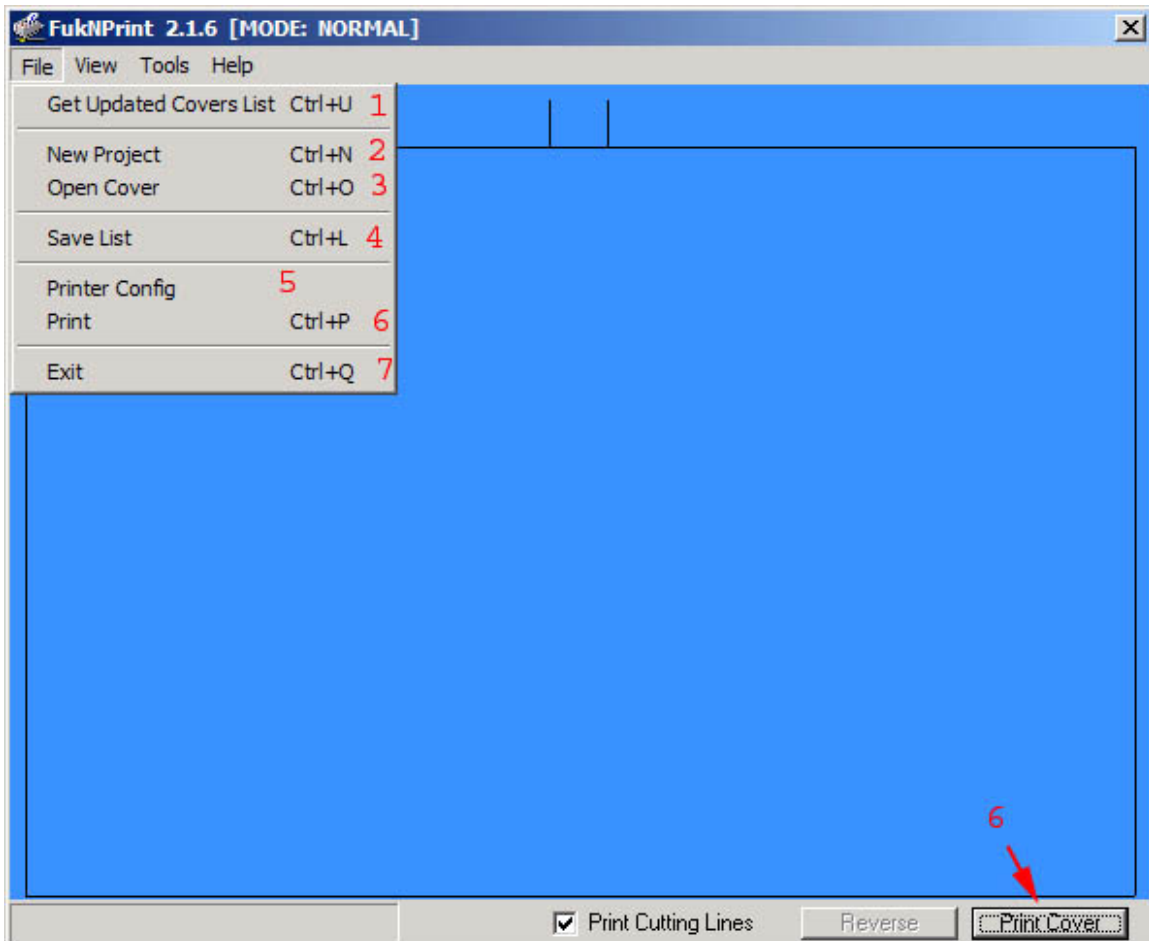
1. Cover List to Process
2. Status of Process
3. "Cancel" Option (Will Clear the Print Queue)
4. Logging (Logs upon completion or failure of a step)



FukNPrint DVD Covers (Menu Details)

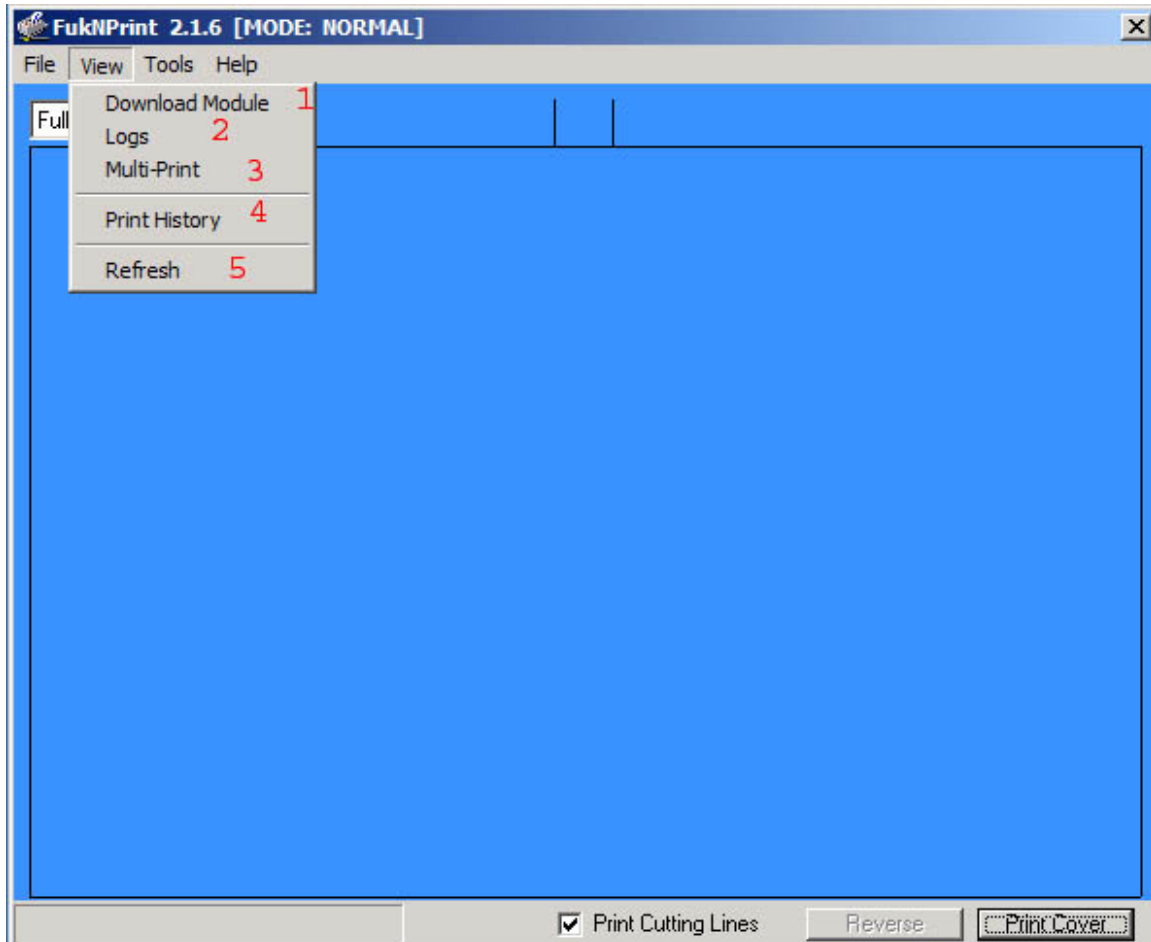
File Menu

1. Update the Covers List for use with the Download / Multi-print mode
2. Reset app and clear all variables for new print job.
3. Open a Cover Image or Cover List depending on the mode the program is in.
4. Save a Cover List for later printing or transporting list to another Computer.
5. Setup Print Defaults for App independent of Windows Settings.
6. Print A Cover or List.
7. Exit FukNPrint DVD Cover Printing Applications.



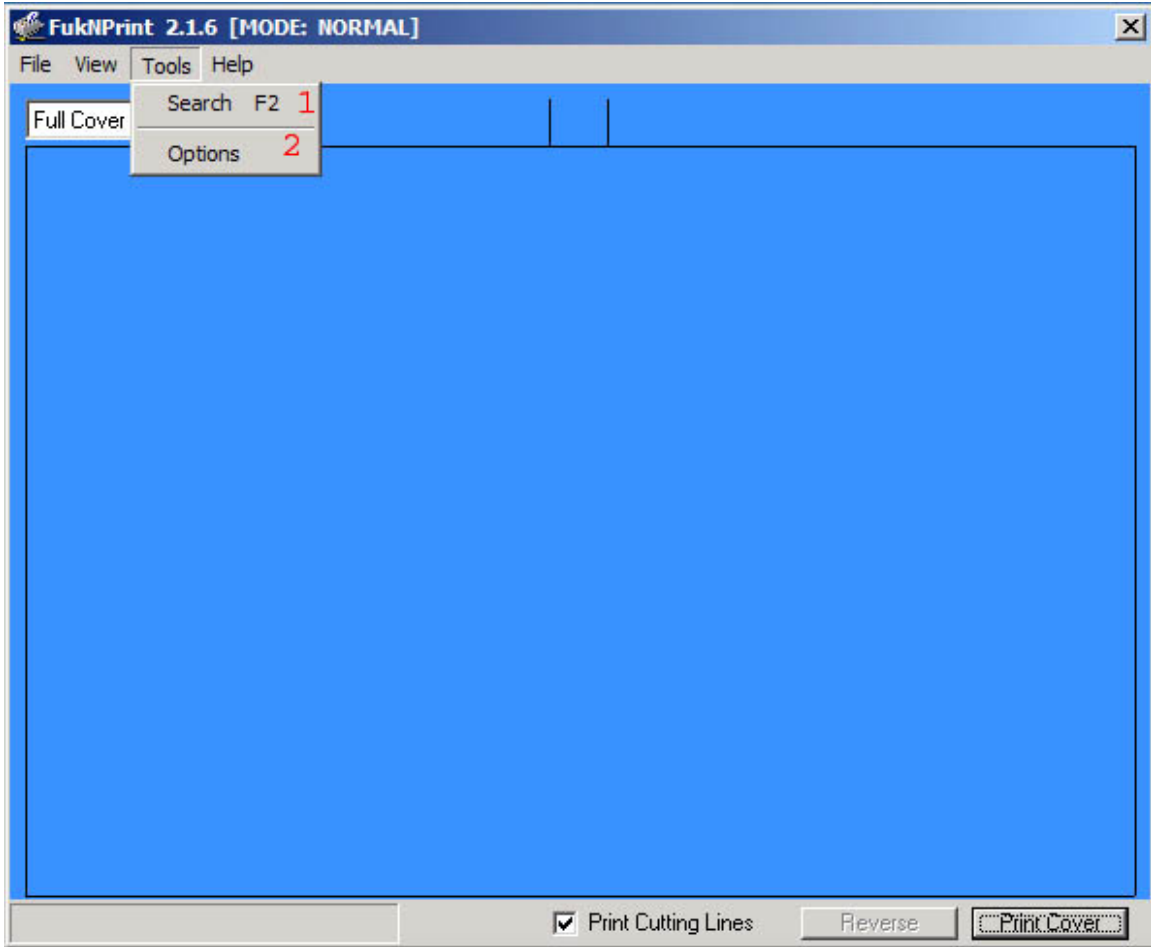

5. Refresh the App



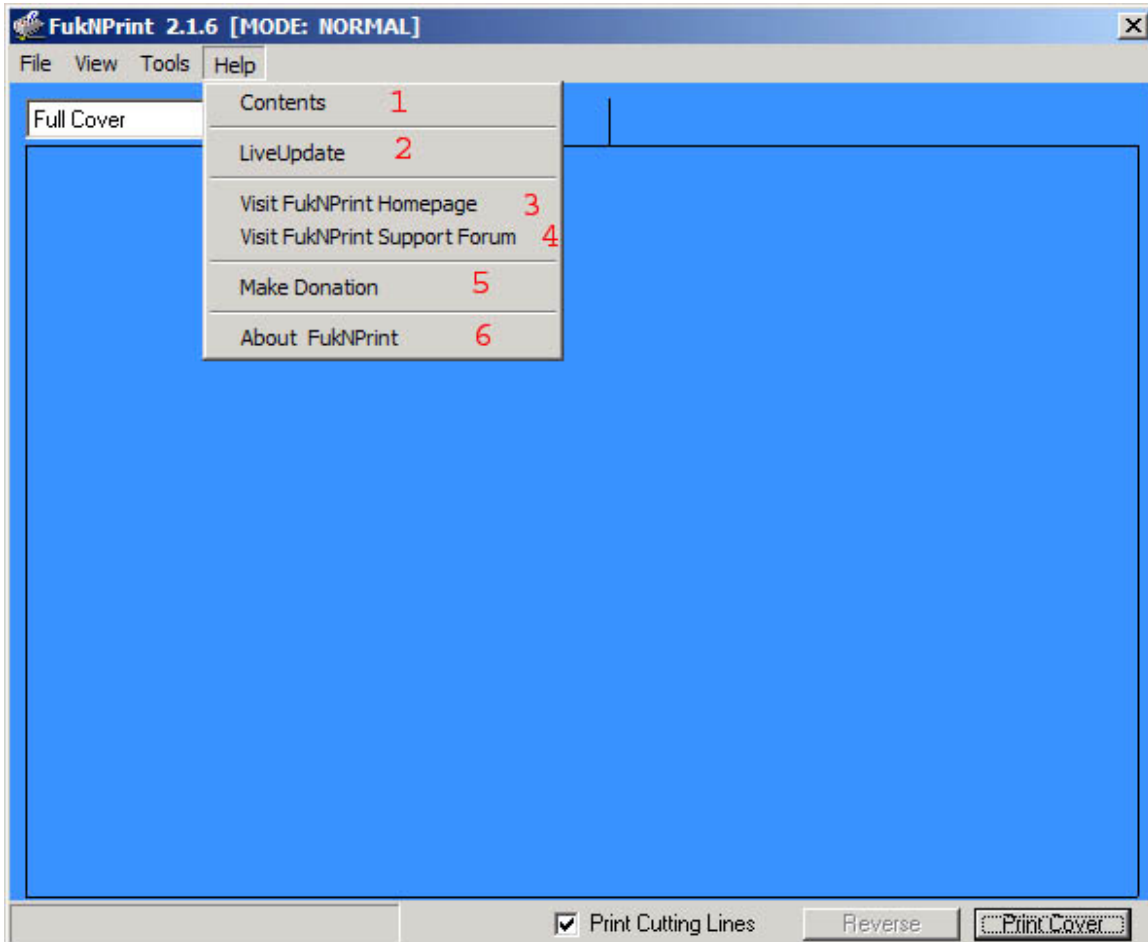

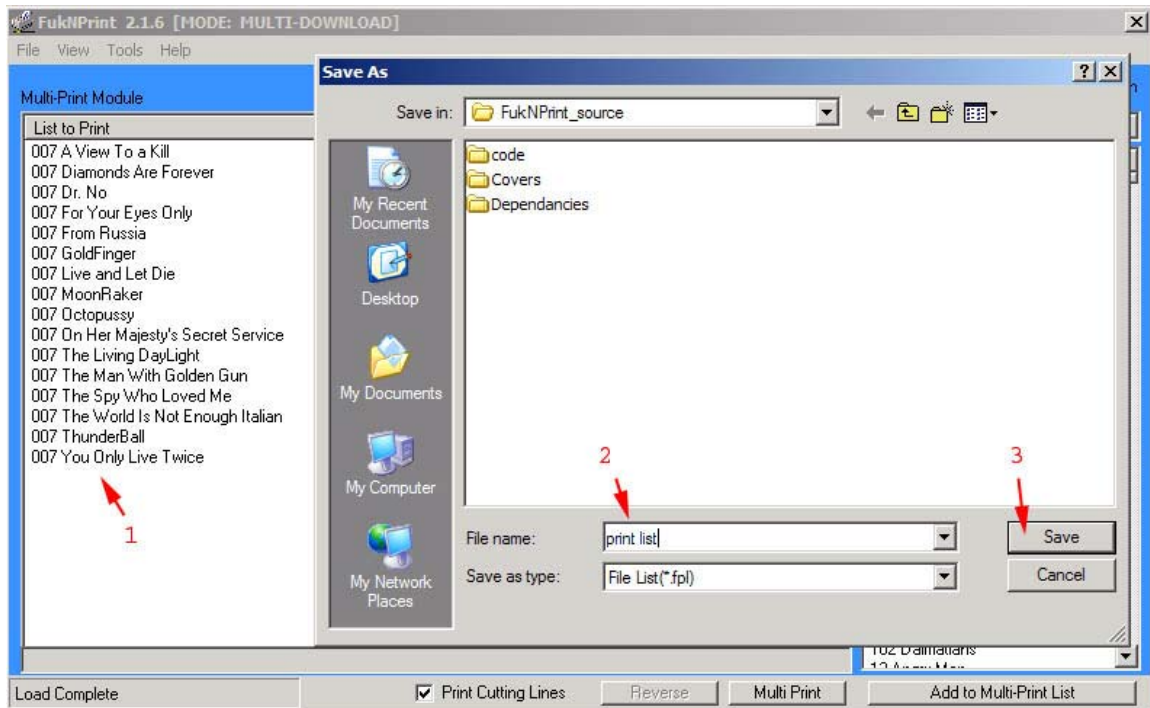

Save Multi-Print List for Later Printing

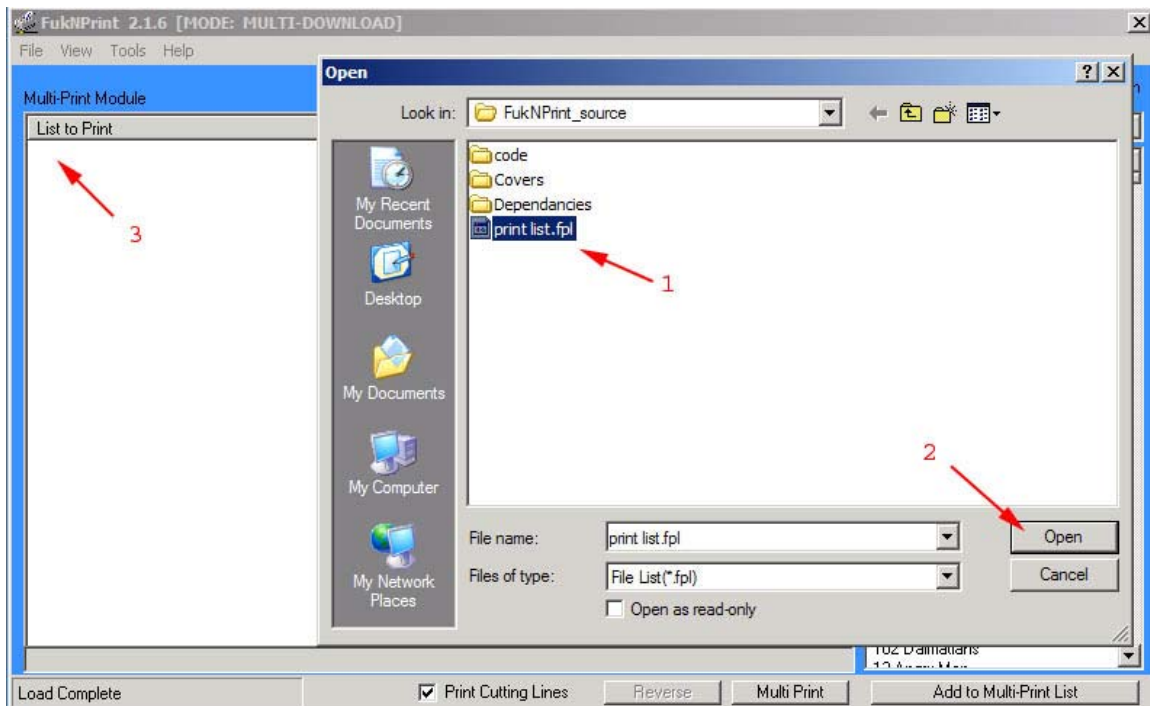
1. Multi-Print List to save.
2. File name to Save As
3. Save



Open Multi-Print List

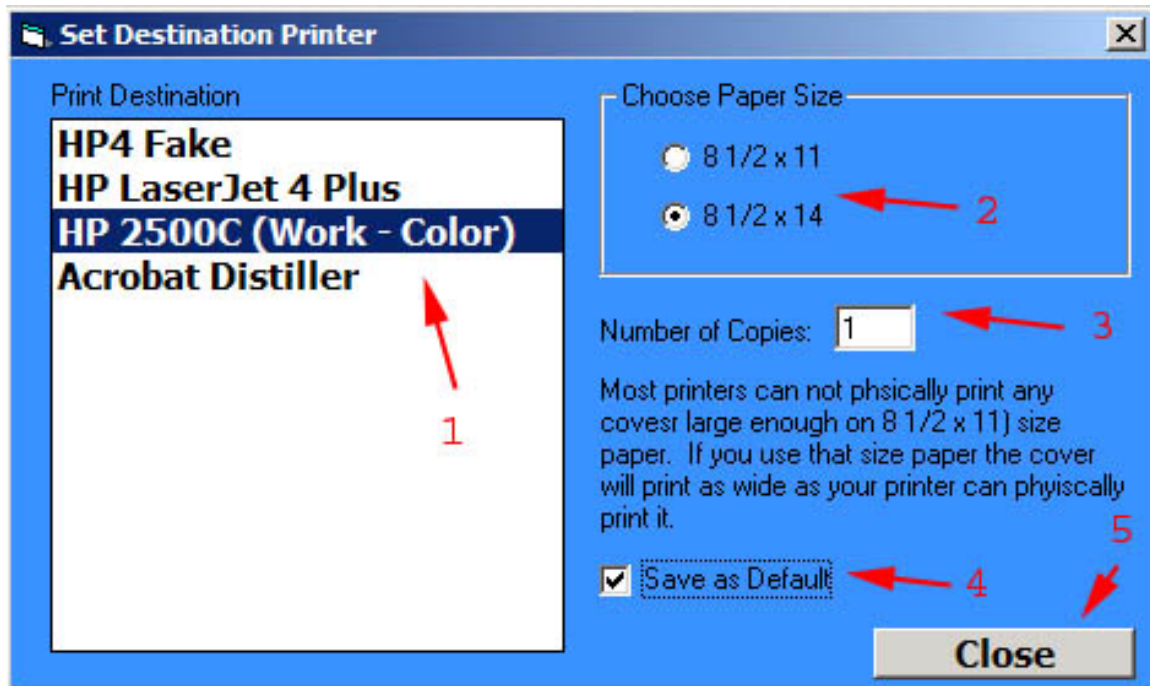
The list can be loaded on any pc that has a version of FukNPrint with “Download and Multi-Print” functionality.

1. List to Load
2. Open List
3. List will load into multi-print window.



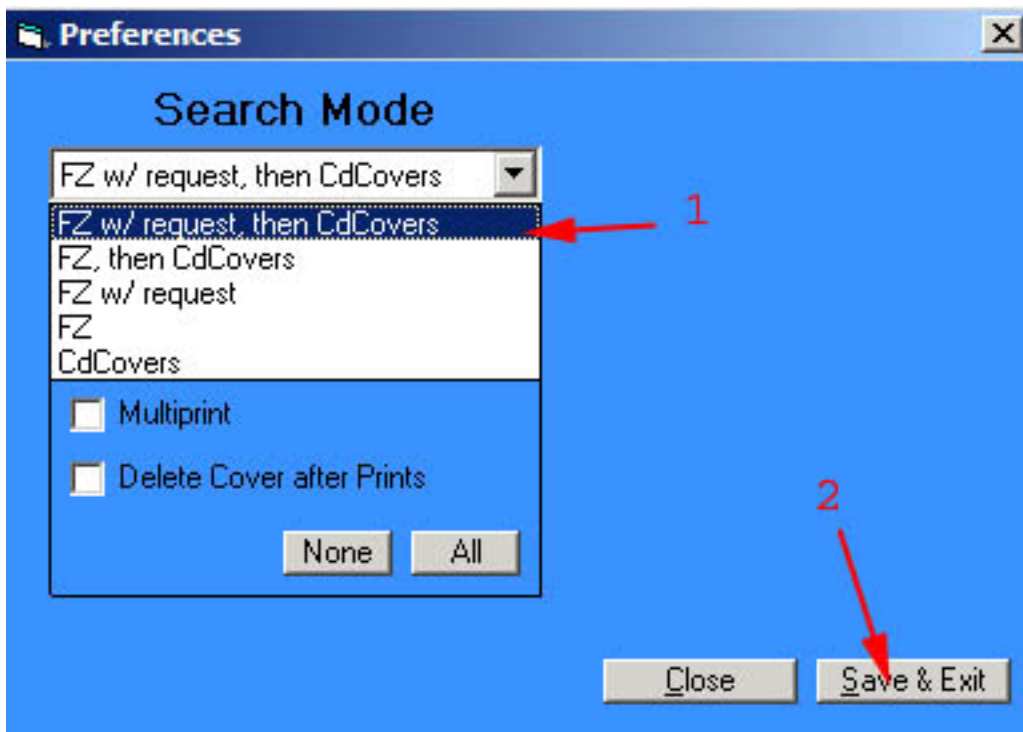
Printer Config Form

1. Destination Printer
2. Output Paper size
3. Number of Copies
4. Save Setting for future use (If you don't save them, before printing form will come up each time.)
5. Close or Print depend on what the mode is in and the caption shows.



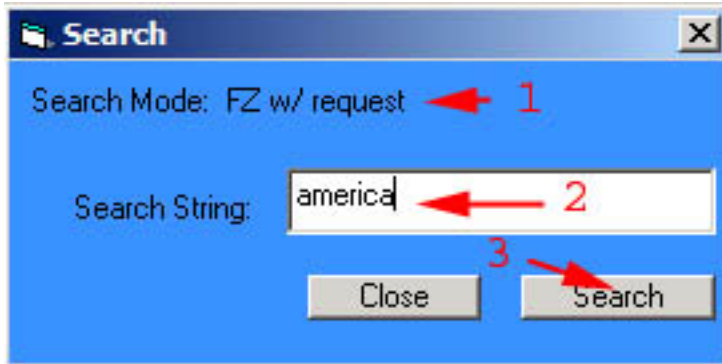
Preferences

1. Submit Mode
 - a. FZ /w request, then CdCovers (search download module, on failure submit request and then search www.cdcovers.cc)
 - b. FZ, then CdCover (search download module, on failure search www.cdcovers.cc)
 - c. FZ w/ request (search download module, on failure submit request)
 - d. FZ (search download module)
 - e. CdCovers (search www.cdcovers.cc)
2. Save Settings



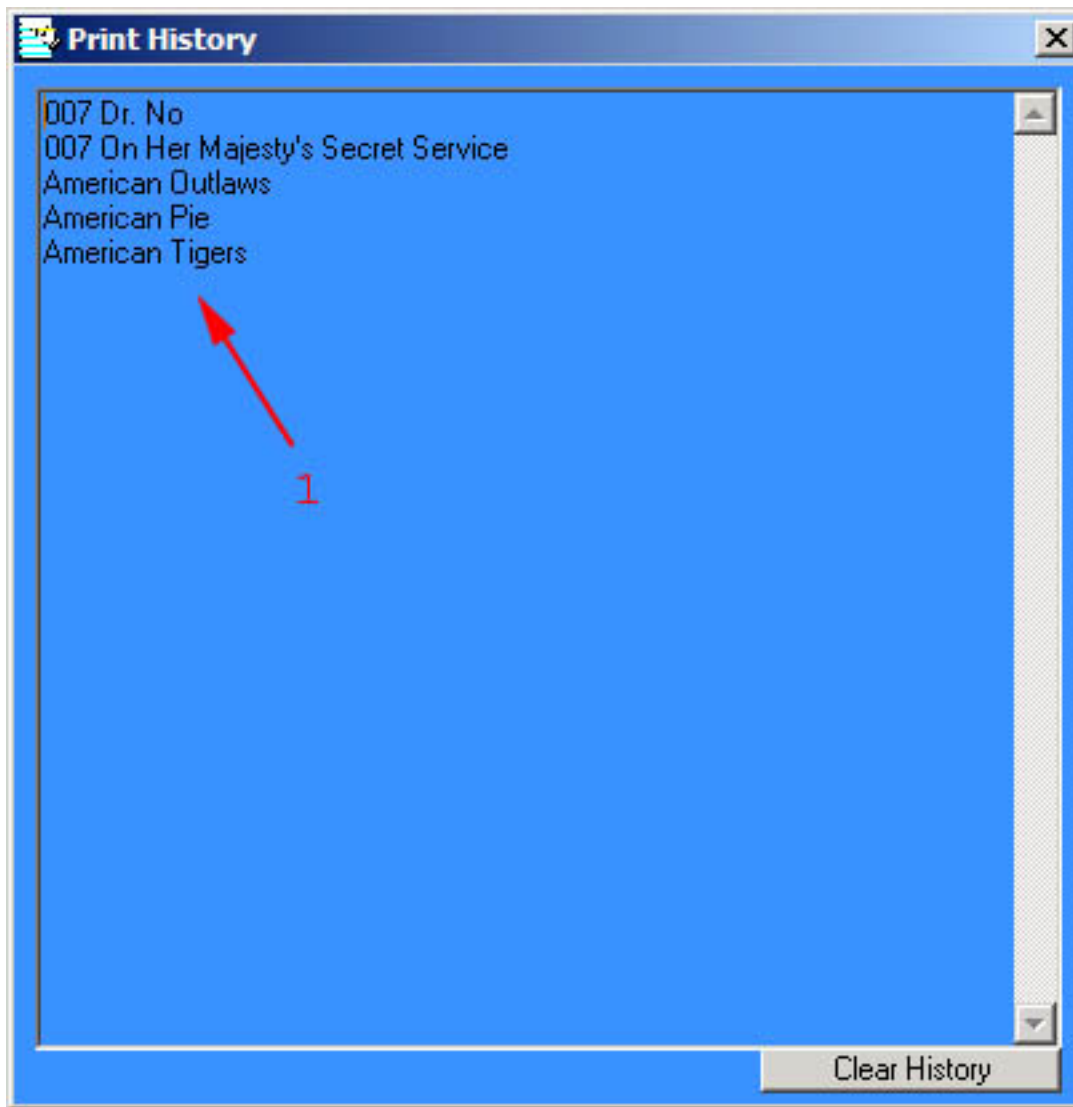
Search Module:

1. The mode the module is in: “Search Fukrulez.com and submit a request for the cover if no matches is found.
