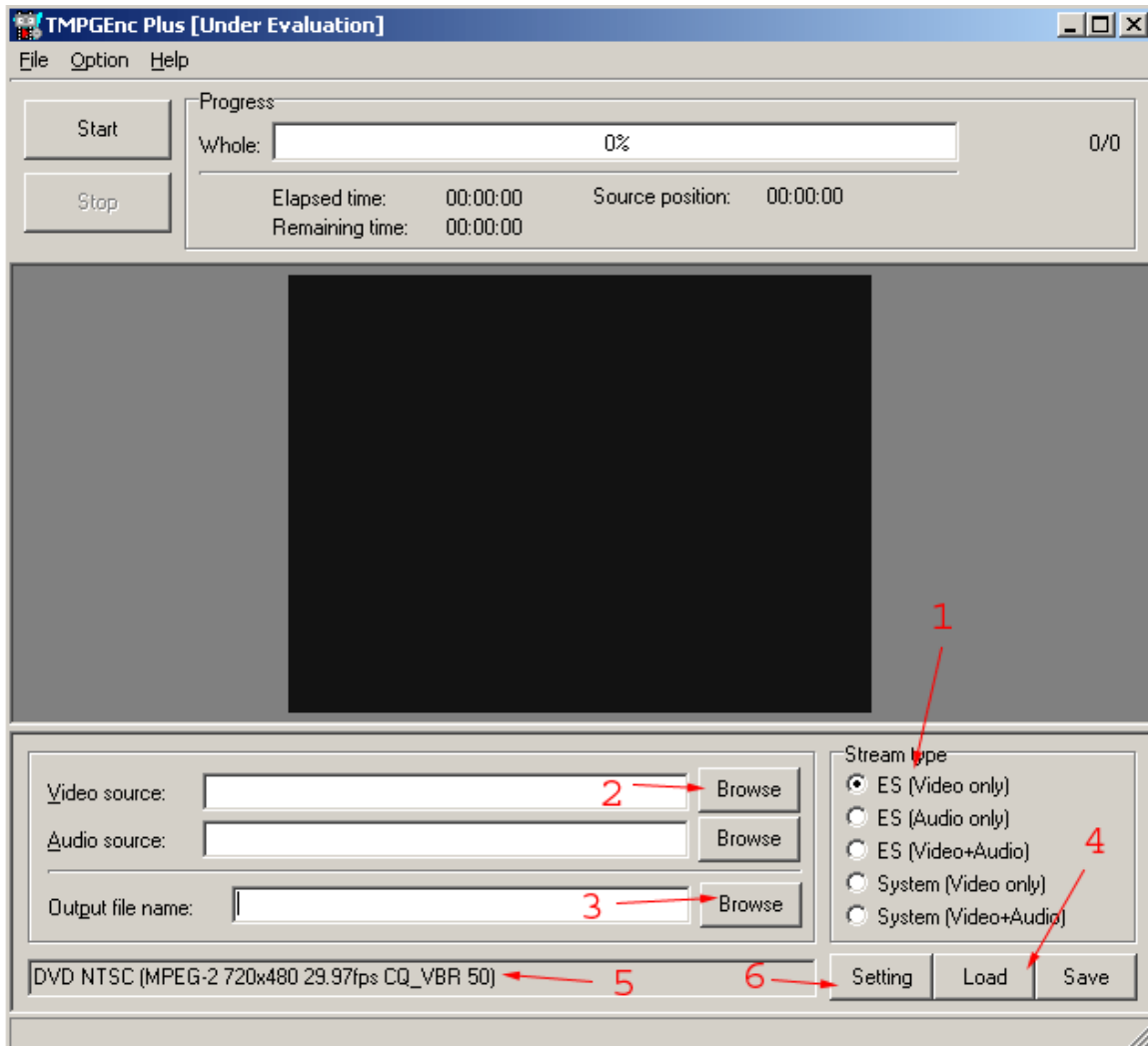


I have found a way to convert from Pal to NTSC. It is very simple just use TMPEnc.

You just need to set:

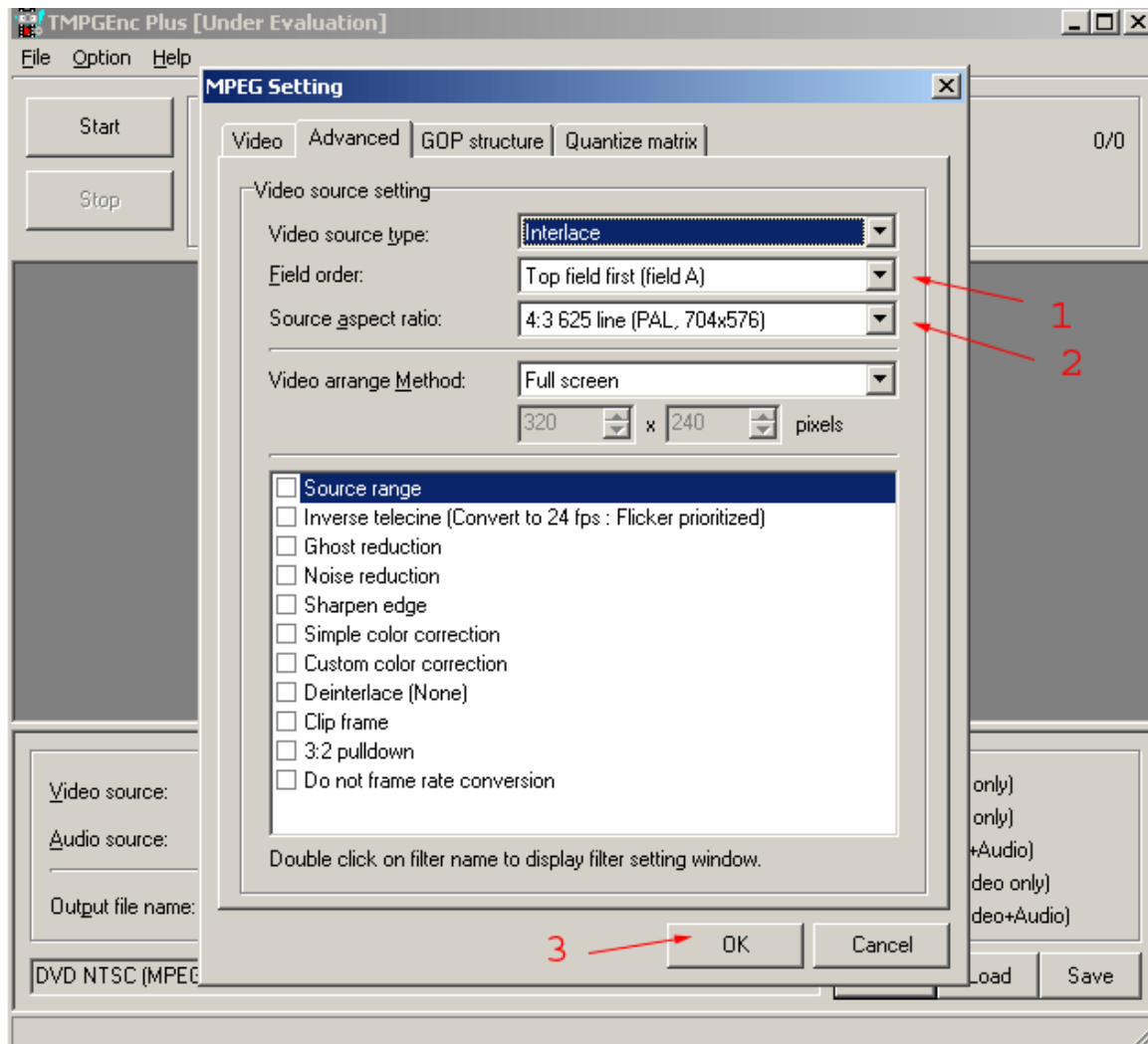
1. Choose Video only
2. Choose the source movie that is in PAL
3. Choose the destination movie file you wish to create.
4. Ensure that you loaded your preferred Output settings. NTSC Template should be sufficient.
5. The settings loaded.
6. View or change settings, loaded from the template.

You can optionally set up a batch encode, if you had your ripper split the files.



In the settings form under the Advanced Tab, verify that it shows the proper settings.

1. Field order
2. Source Aspect ration (this should get set automatically depending on the source file)
3. Click OK to save.



The return and start encoding, should go fairly quickly. Watch your encoding settings, if you have it set too high, you might have to shrink it. In other words if you are not familiar with DVD encoding certain rates will allow an XX minute movie fit on DVD-R

The rate is a relationship of length.
