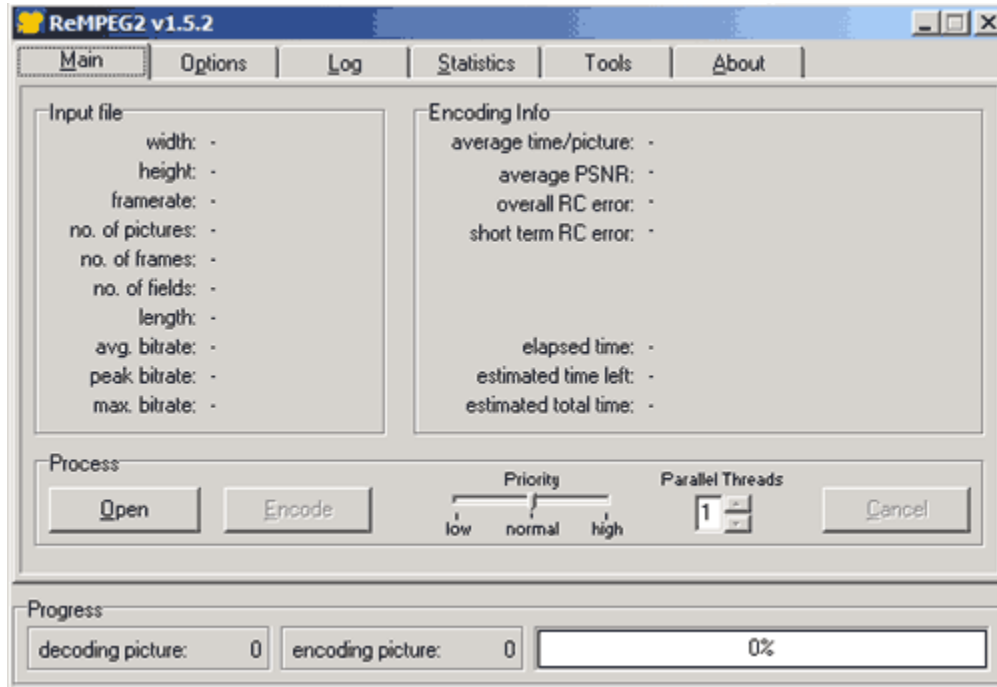


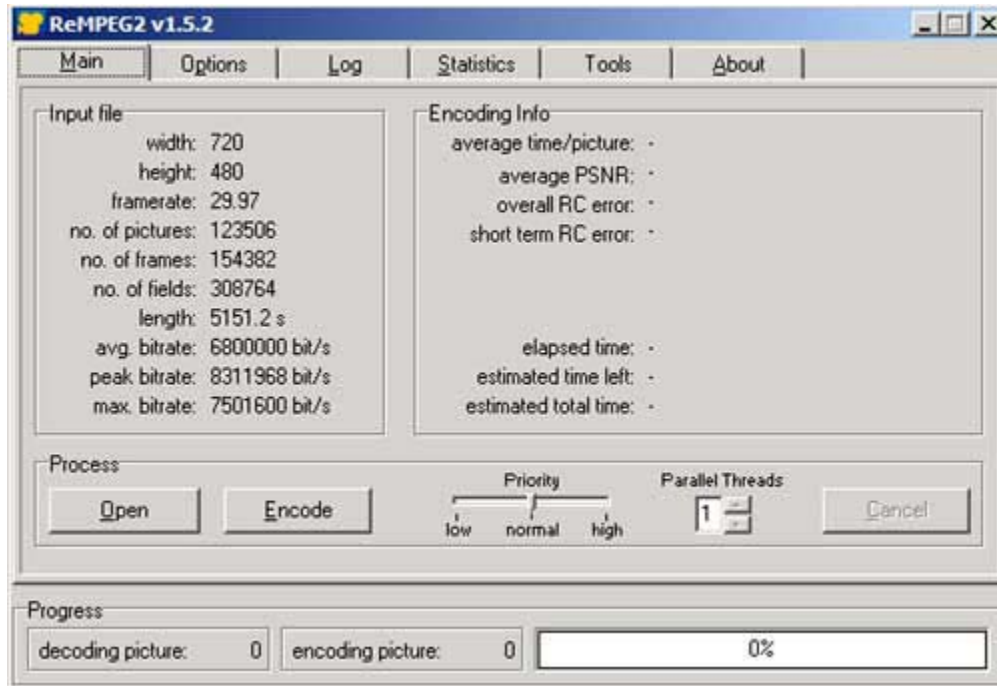
This is a program to shrink the size of the DVD video in order to fit it on one disk while trying to keep the original quality as much as possible.

ReMPeg works by changing the scale factor of movie. IF you do any movies that are "16x9" you must set the aspect ratio properly into DVD Maestro.

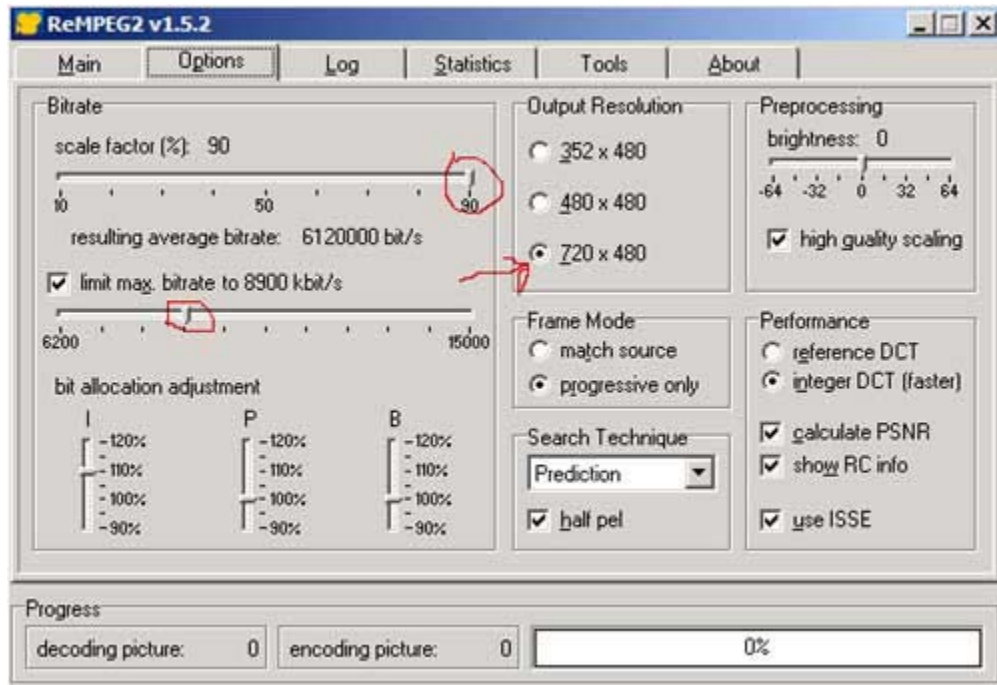
When ReMPeg first Loads it looks like this. You want click Open and then browse to you vts\_xx\_video [e0] \_xx.m2v file.



It takes several minutes to parse the Movie File, once complete it will look like this.



Once the Video is open you then need to set the video resolution to "720x480" and then set the scale factor to match the one you got from FukNCalcDVD. Then you can set a maximum bit rate around 8100 is pretty good.



Once everything is set click on encode it will ask you for the file name you want to encode to (do not use the same name) you will lose your file and have to start over. I clicked the file and add "re\_" in front of the original file name such as "re\_vts\_xx\_video\_ [e0] \_xx.m2v
